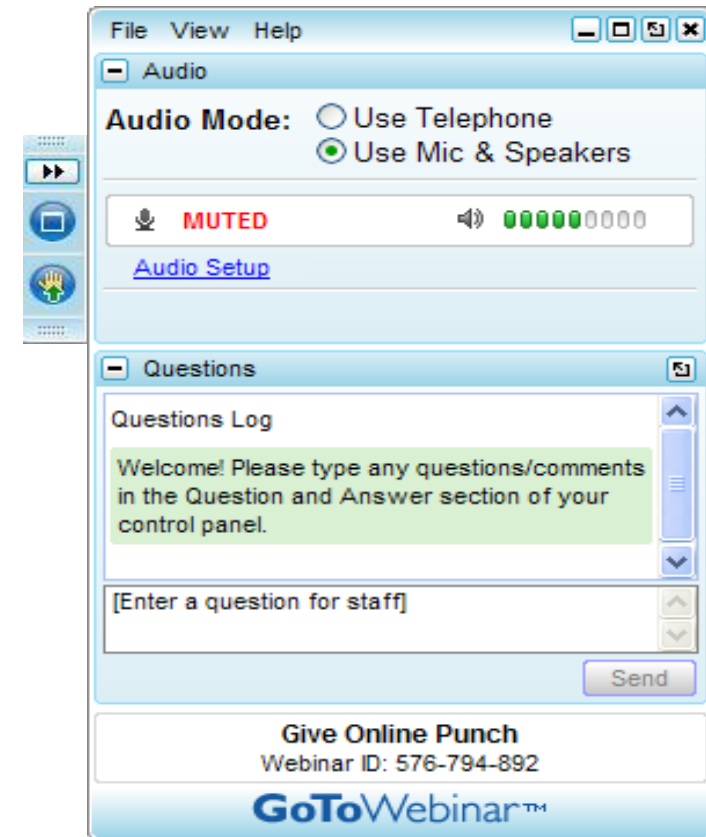

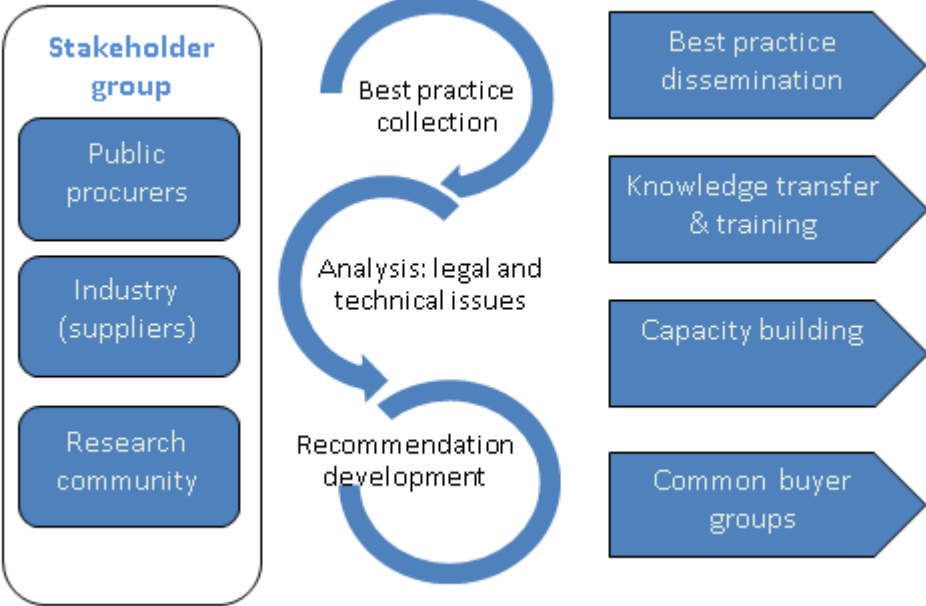

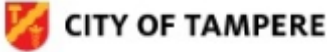
Support Procurements for Innovative transport and mobility solutions in City Environment

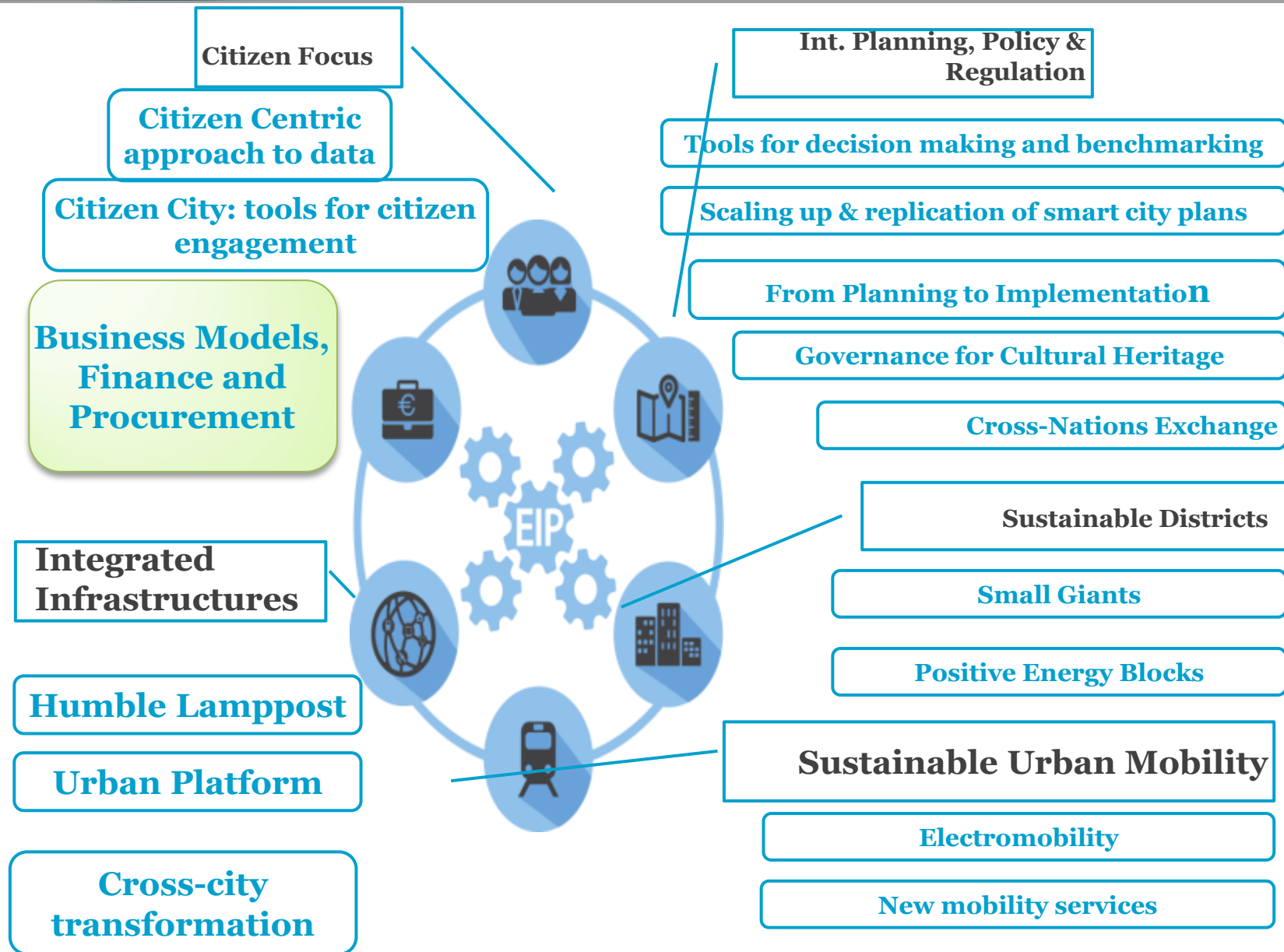
