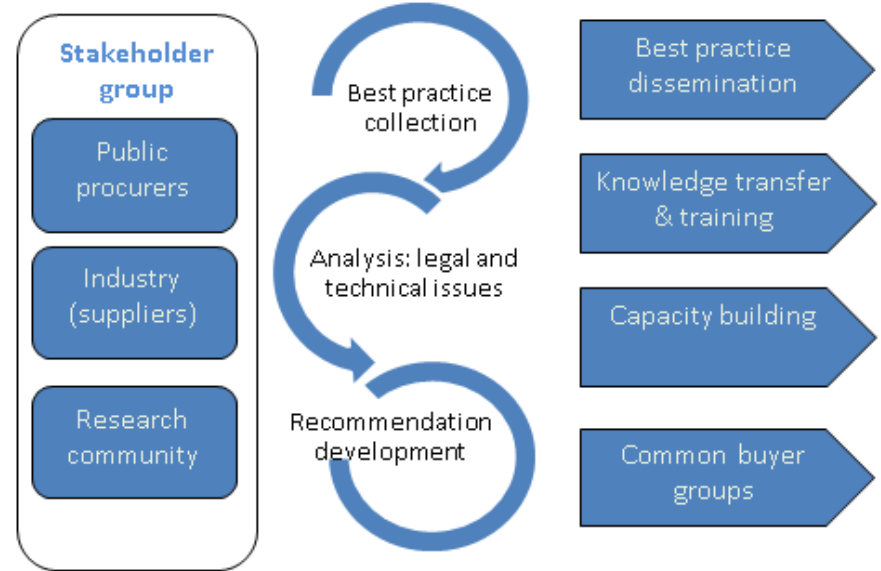

- **Support common buyer groups**



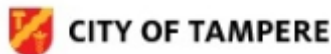
